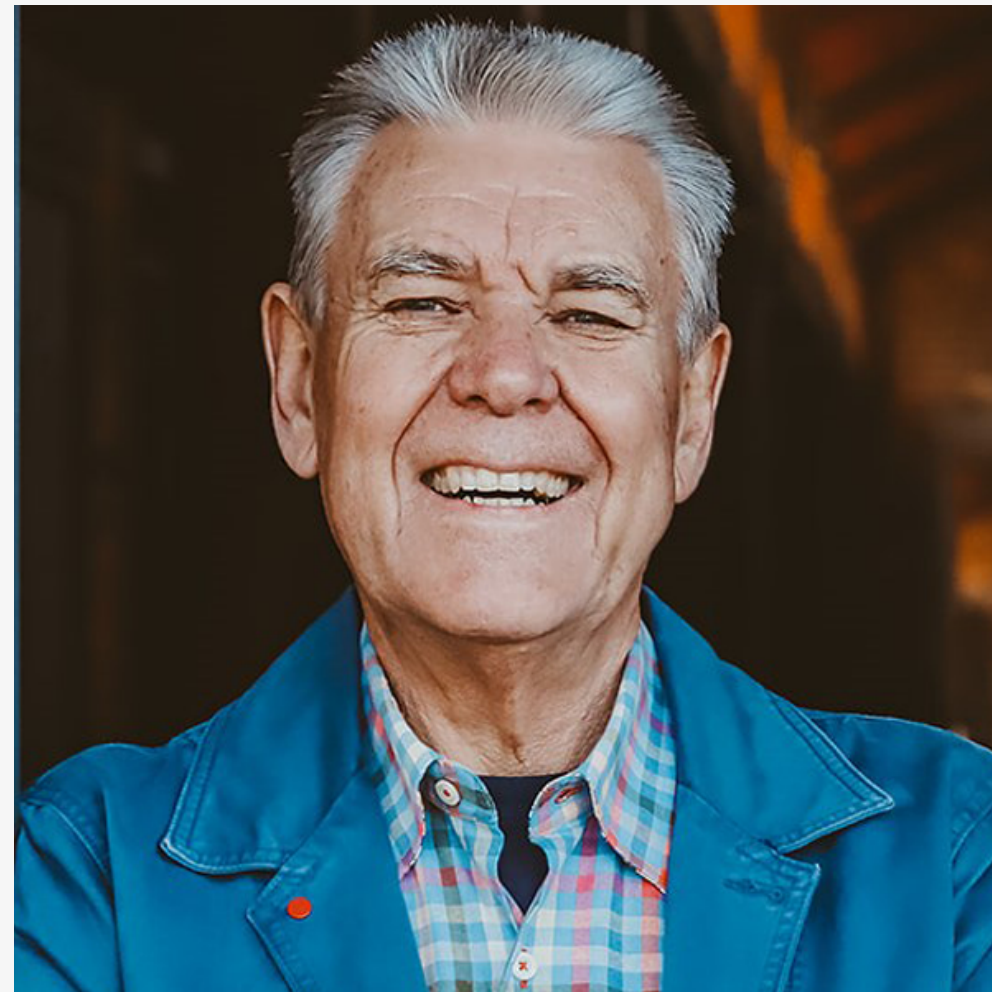

SEPARATION OF PERSONAL SUPPORT & MINISTRY WORK

All PVI's staff, including board members, are volunteers, who are responsible for their own support. Staff must either be self-supporting and yet available for full time service, or alternatively they must raise their own support.

PVI pays no wages or salaries, or remuneration of any nature. Professional services of outside individuals or organisations, such as bookkeeping and auditing, are paid for out of our ten per cent deduction for admin from donations,

The ten per cent admin fee also covers bank charges, money transfer commissions, and extraordinary travel costs.

This arrangement gives our donors, partners, and supporters the comfort of knowing that at least ninety per cent of their funding will go directly into the project being supported.

FINANCIAL OVERSIGHT

Our Financial Director, Leon Combrink, is a Chartered Accountant CA (SA), registered with the South African Board of Chartered Accountants. He is in full time employment as Group Accountant with a South African corporation.

All financial transactions are seen by at least three people: one of the directors, the Financial Director, and our bookkeeper, who has been instructed to question any financial issue with any of the board members, if she feels that there is something that is not clear, questionable, or not in line with our financial policy.

Our financial year end is the last day of February. Our bookkeeper produces, together with our Financial Director, a full set of accounts after the year end, which are submitted to Alice Business Consulting for auditing. These audited accounts are available to all supporters, donors, and partners.

FINANCIAL OVERSIGHT CONTINUED

PVI owns no property, vehicles, equipment or plant, in fact no assets of any nature. All computer equipment, cell phones, printers, etc. are owned privately by staff members. We do not pay any rentals or insurance contracts. We are a virtual organisation.

This structure allows us to operate with the absolute minimum overheads.

All our board members, and many of our staff members contribute financially either directly or indirectly to the ministry.

On occasion, a personal supporter of one of our staff may request us to administer their monthly support, which we undertake to do, subject to the ten per cent admin charge.
